

SINGLES CHALLENGE LADDER FORMAT

- All matches will be 8 game pro-sets
- If the match is not finished In the 1 1/2 hours of allotted time and the score is still tied you must play a 12 point tie-breaker (first to 7 winning by 2) to determine the winner.
- If the match is not finished In the 1 1/2 hours of allotted time and one player is up a break they will be declared the winner at the end of court time.
- Please be courteous to players who are coming on the court after you. If the score is tied please begin a tie-breaker at least 5 minutes before the end of your allotted time.
- Players of all levels will initially be placed on the ladder in random order.
- New players are encouraged to continue to join the ladder but will begin at the bottom of the ladder and work their way up.
- Order of finish will be taken into account when seeding the Adult Indoor Club Championships to be held in February.

RULES

- You may challenge up as many as 5 spots on the ladder.
- The person you challenge has 2 weeks to play the match with you or they automatically lose by forfeit (unless they are out of town).
- You must play at least one match every two weeks either by challenging someone else or being challenged yourself. If you fail to do so you will drop 5 spots.
- If a challenger wins the match they take their opponents spot and the opponent drops one spot on the ladder.
- If the challenger loses both players maintain their spot.
- Ladder play will have male and female players combined unless league size dictates separate divisions are necessary.

COST

- Special Reduced Court Rate Fee of \$16 No Pass \$12.00 with Pass per match
- This includes court fee, balls and tax
- There Is no "league fee" to play in the Singles Challenge Ladder
